Morris County American Legion Scholarship Post Information Guide



1. Two scholarships will be awarded, each in the amount of two thousand, five hundred dollars (\$2,500).
2. Applicant must be a high school graduate or a member of a high school graduating class or currently attending a college, university or authorized technical school.
3. Each scholarship is for one year only in the amount of two thousand, five hundred dollars (\$2,500)
4. Applicant must be enrolled in an accredited college, university or technical school in the United States.
5. Applicant must be a currently paid-up member of The American Legion, the child or grandchild of a deceased U.S. Armed Forces veteran who was a member of a Morris County American Legion Post (or would have been eligible for membership) and who was/is a resident of Morris County.
6. There are no limitations on the number of applications submitted by a Post; however, all applications must be verified by the Post and signed by the Post Adjutant.
7. Forward all applications along with a copy of the DD214 or equivalent or current membership card to the Chairman, Morris County Scholarship Committee. The Chairman is listed in the County Organization Book and on the "County Organization" page, this website.
8. Deadline for application to the American Legion Post is April 1st. Deadline for applications to the Morris County Scholarship Committee is the April County Meeting. The Scholarship Committee will select the scholarship winners, by lottery drawing, prior to the May Convention Meeting.
9. The scholarship winners will be announced at the May Convention Meeting where symbolic awards will be presented.
10. Each award check will be made out to both the winner and the college, university or technical school and will be mailed to the school in August.
11. If the winner fails to complete the full year of school, then the scholarship funds will be considered to be an interest-free loan and must be repaid to the Morris County committee in full.
